
Term End Highlights of the Junior School 2020I



Students then wrote about the values they have and what they need to improve on. Some also made kindness cards for their friends.






Astronaut Hazzan Al Mansoori "The First Emirati in space."

COVID - 19 AWARENESS PROGRAMME

A new type of coronavirus, abbreviated COVID-19, is causing an outbreak of respiratory (lung) disease. It is important to plan for any possible outbreaks if the risk level increases in the future.

Concern over this new virus can make children and families anxious. Acknowledging some level of concern, without panicking, is appropriate and can result in taking actions that reduce the risk of illness.

OOEHS Health department conducted an awareness program to enforce illness prevention habits such as avoid close contact with people who are sick, stay home when you are sick, Cover your cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue, and then throw the tissue in the trash, Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth. Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe. including frequent hand washing or use of hand cleansers.
