




# **Sharjah Book Fair Cultural Programme.**

# **Open House**


"We Meet To Make A Difference"




# **Commemoration Day**

Juniors observes silence from 11.00 am to 11.01am in honour of the country's heroes








# **National Day**

The Theme for the event was 'Movers and Shakers' The Front liners have 'moved' us with their dedication to 'shake' out the COVID 19 from the world.


Our Principal Ms. Saleema Mahmoodi, in the presence of the senior management, administration staff, students and parents declared the meet open.
