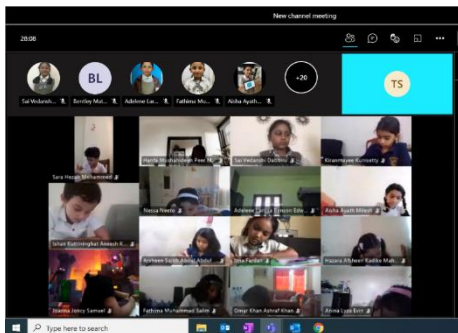
# Examinations- October

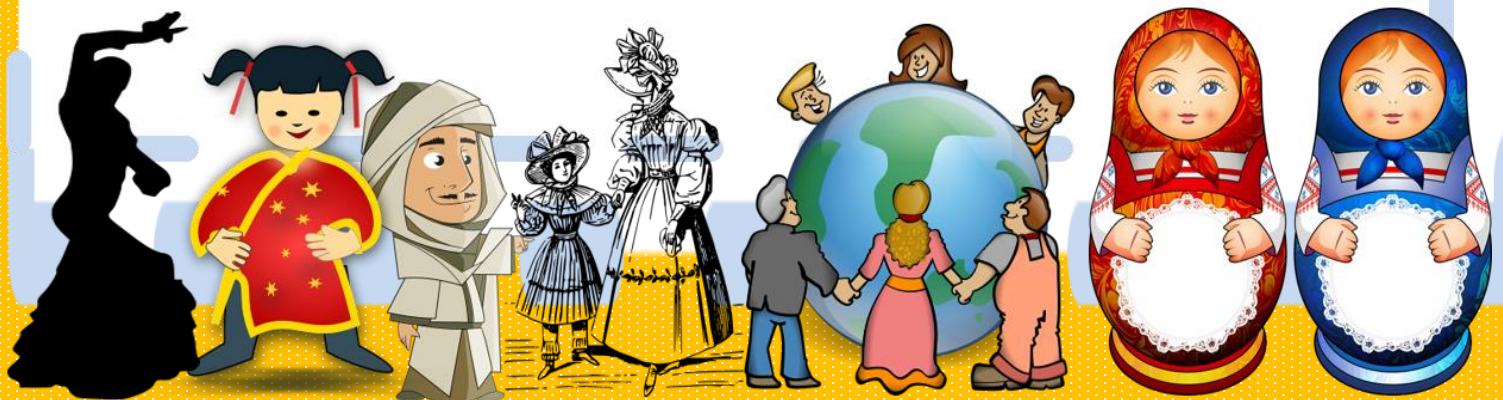




# Our Own Parent Council

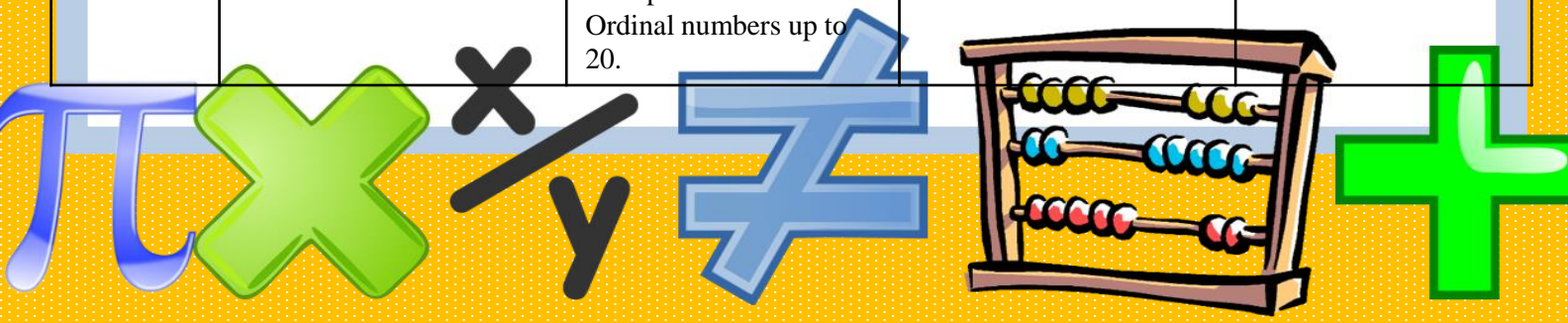

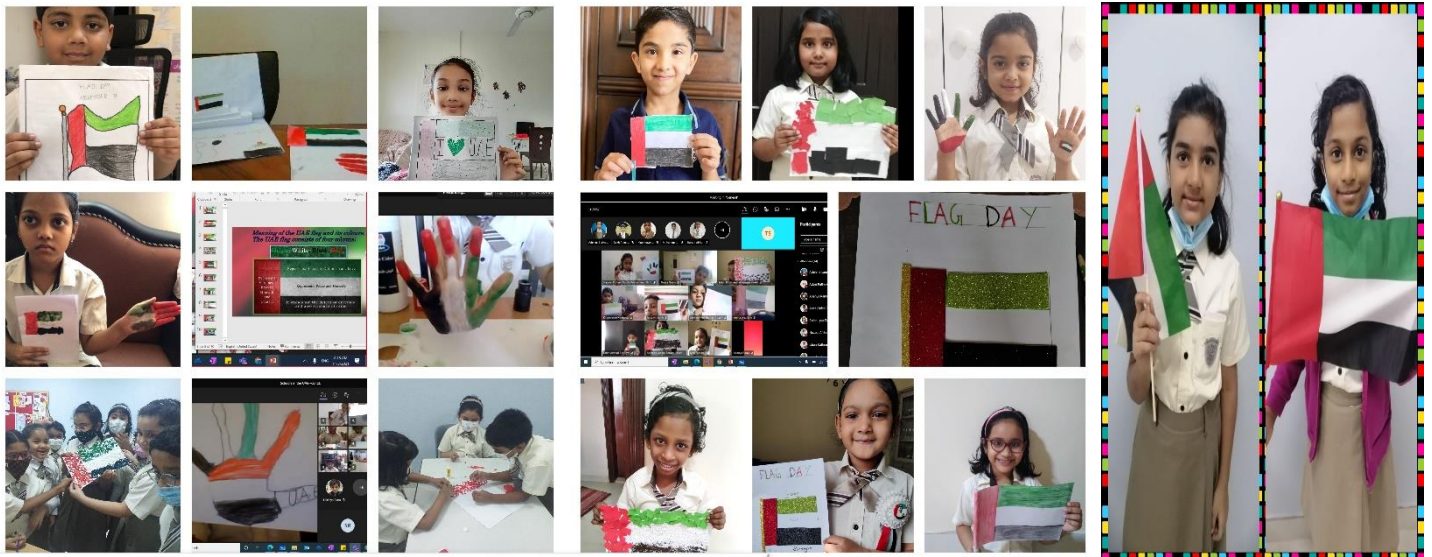
# United Nations Day

# International Children's Day

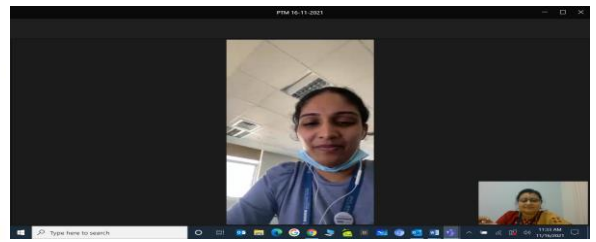
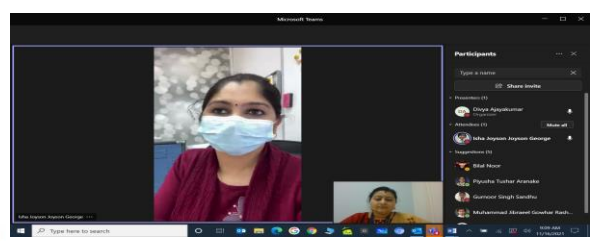

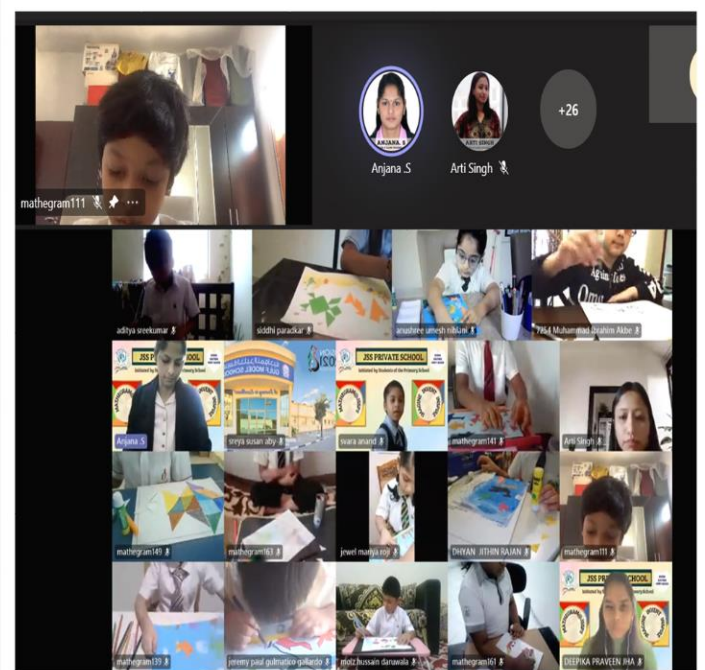




# Inter School Mathegram Competition
