2ND FEB 24

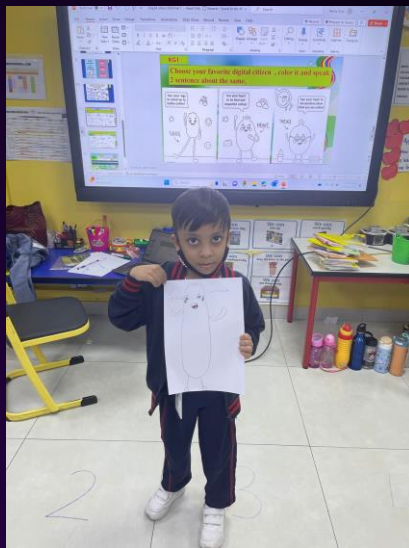
