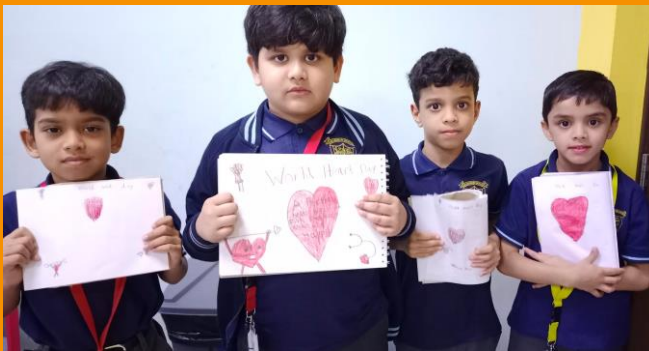


World Heart Day

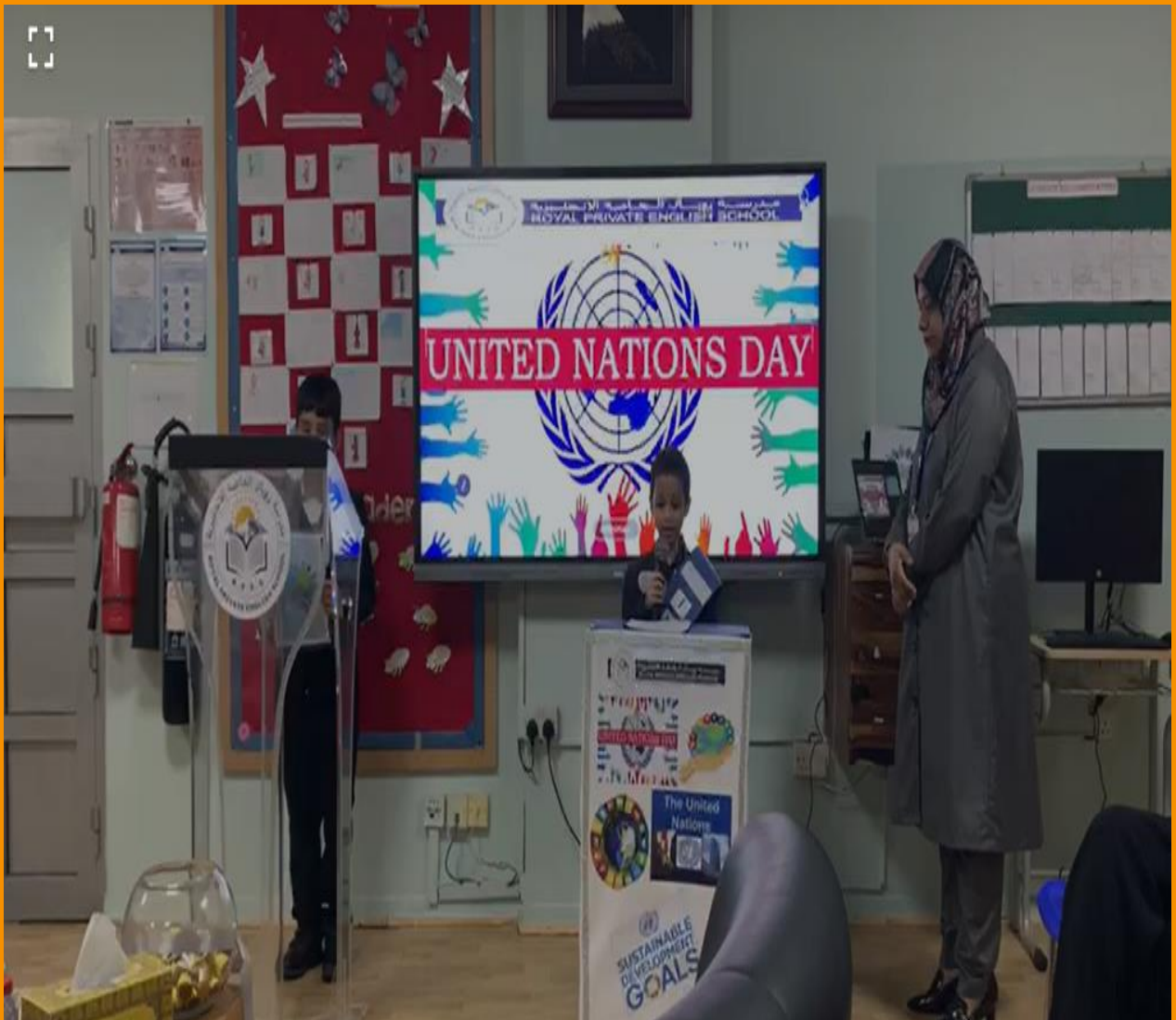

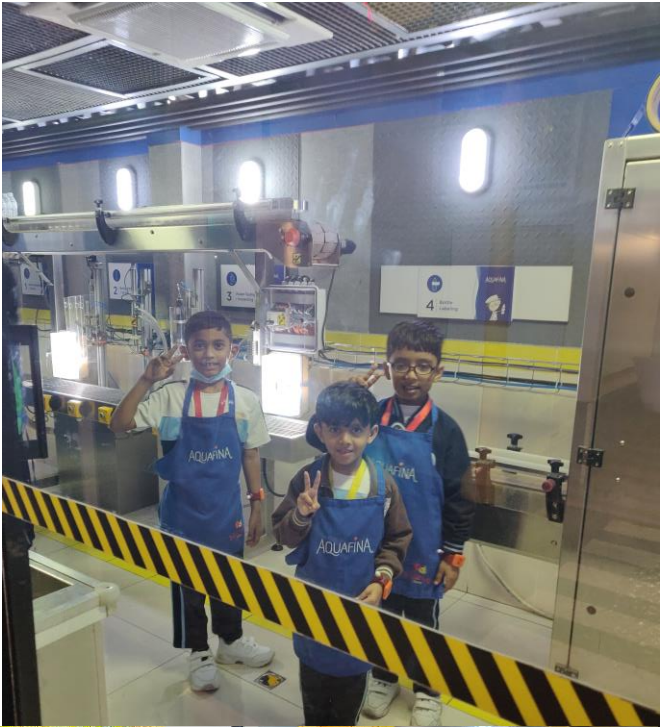

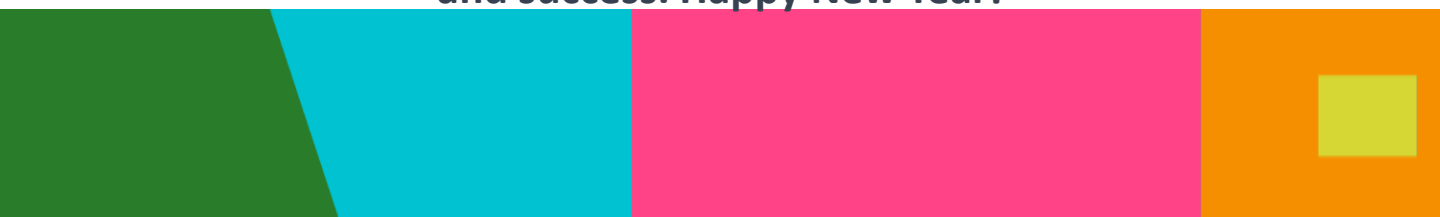
A Fresh Start: Primary Students' New Year's Resolutions
