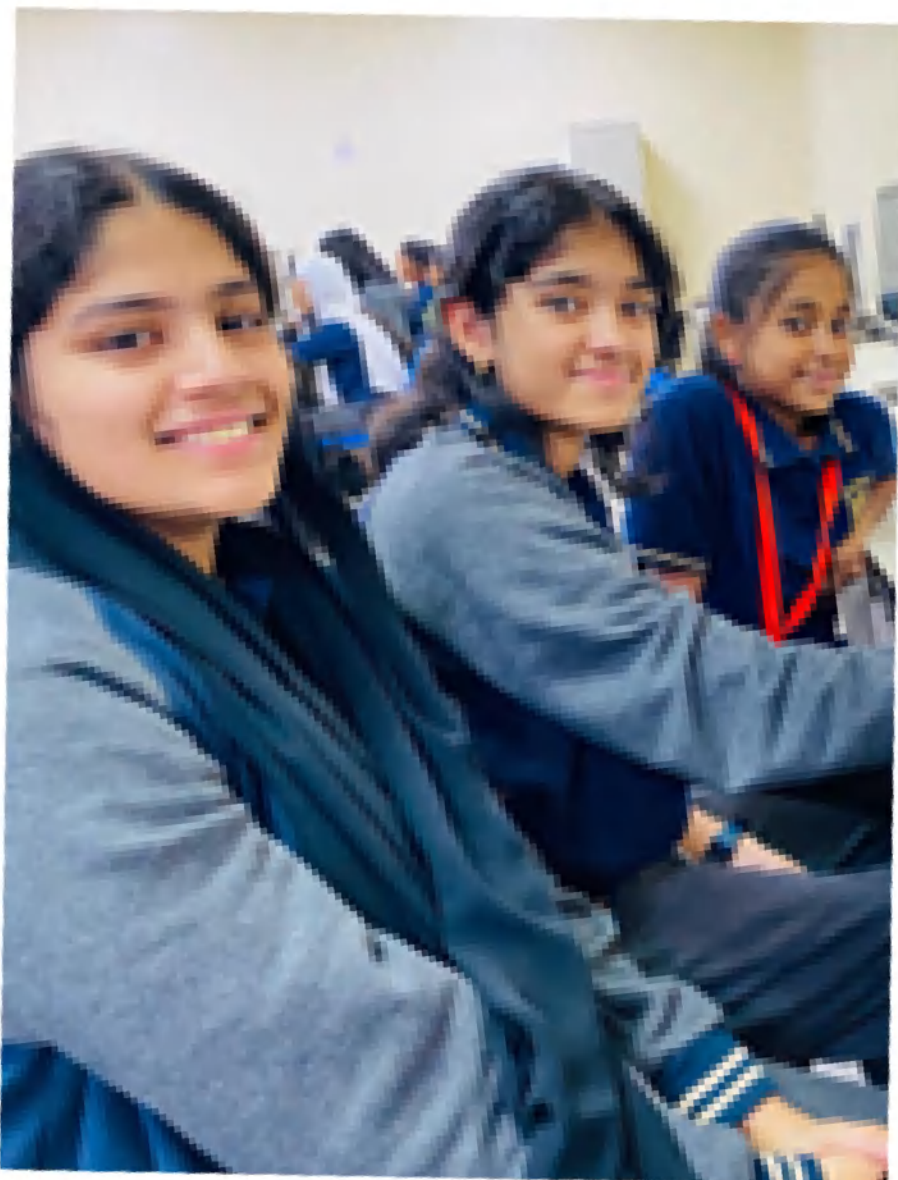
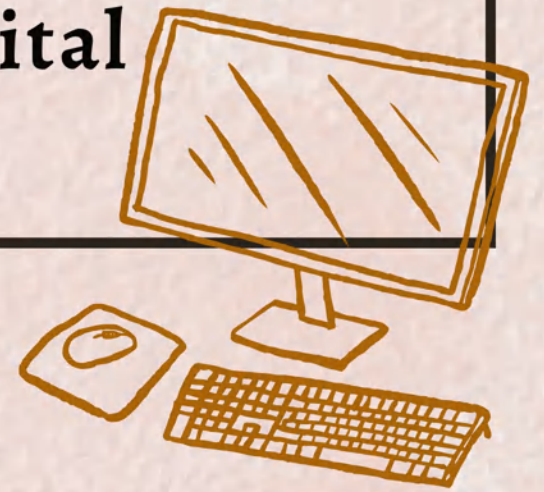




# NATIONAL TECHNOLOGY DAY

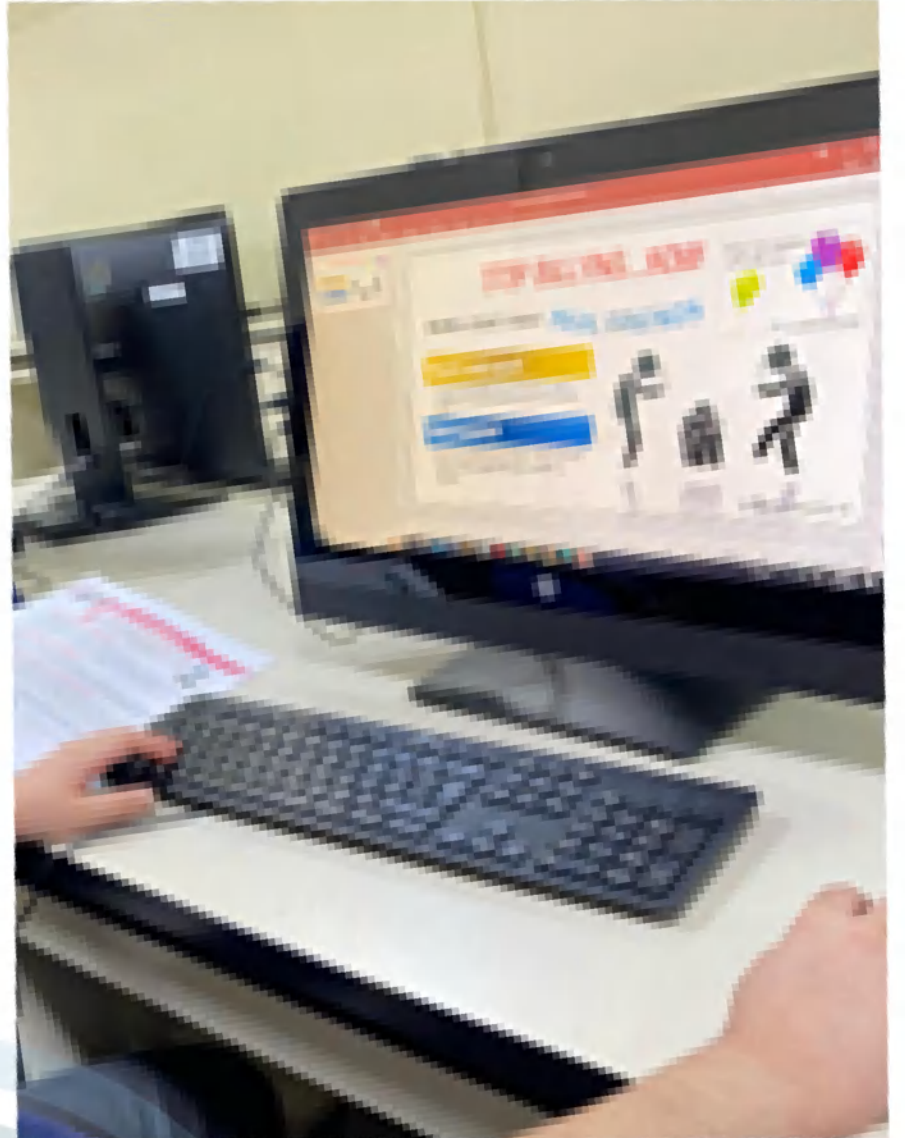
MONDAY, JANUARY 8 2024

On Jan 22, 2024, our CBSE Middle School English Department hosted an Intra School Elocution Competition.

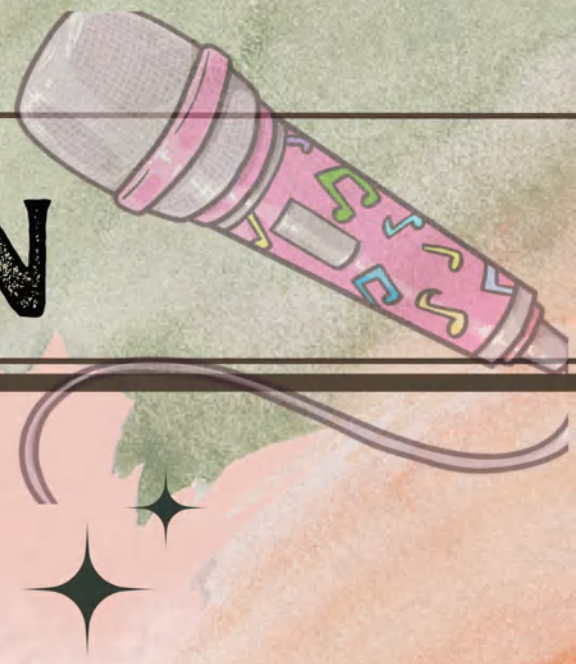
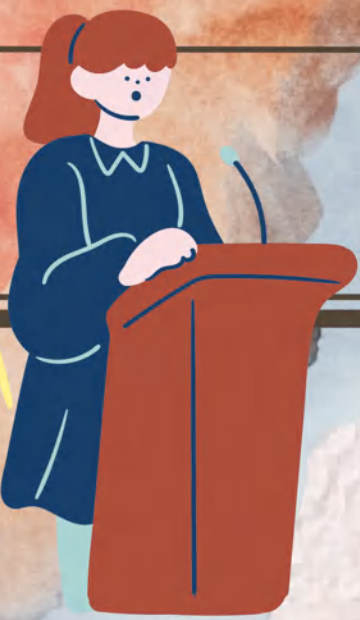
36 talented students from Grade V-VIII mesmerized us with their eloquence, humor, and insights, all in just 2-3 minutes each.

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2024

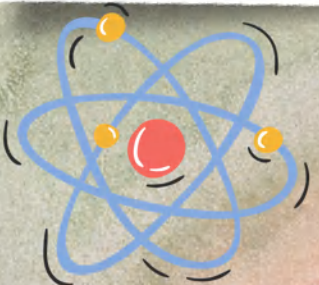

A gathering of the 200 parties from different nations once again, to combat climate change, promote sustainable development and strengthen global cooperation — that was the spirit of the COP28 (28th Conference of Parties), hosted last year by the UAE. The green banners couldn't be missed as I walked through the Expo City, Dubai.

COP28 was presided by Dr. Sultan Al Jaber, who led the opening session. It provided a platform for activists from all nations to share innovations, policies, and best practices in the pursuit of a more sustainable and resilient future. Pledges were taken on finances, food systems, renewable energy, reducing the use of coal and enhancing use of nuclear power. Major oil and gas companies took vows to decrease the global carbon dioxide and methane emissions. A funding of \$1 billion will go towards this effort.

From its Solar powered street lamps and plant based bottles (in Al Ain) to CCUS (Carbon Capture Utilisation and Storage) facilities by ADNOC, the country surges ahead in the field of sustainable development.

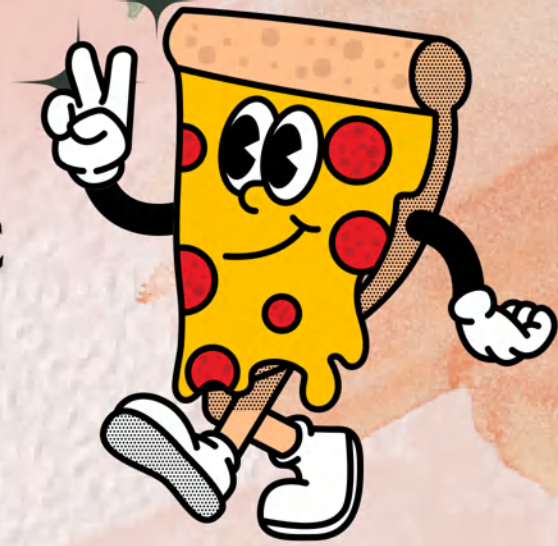

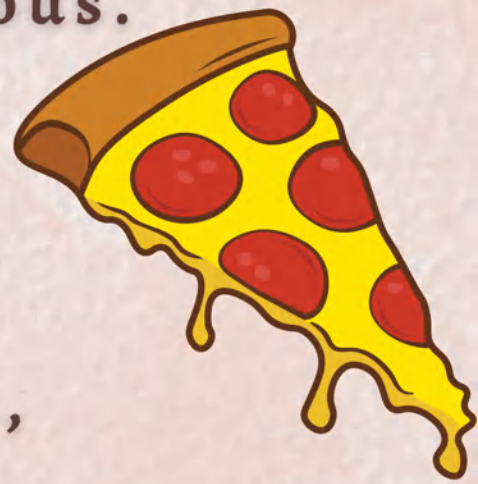


Pizza is my soul food,

A thrill! A joy! A gala throughout!

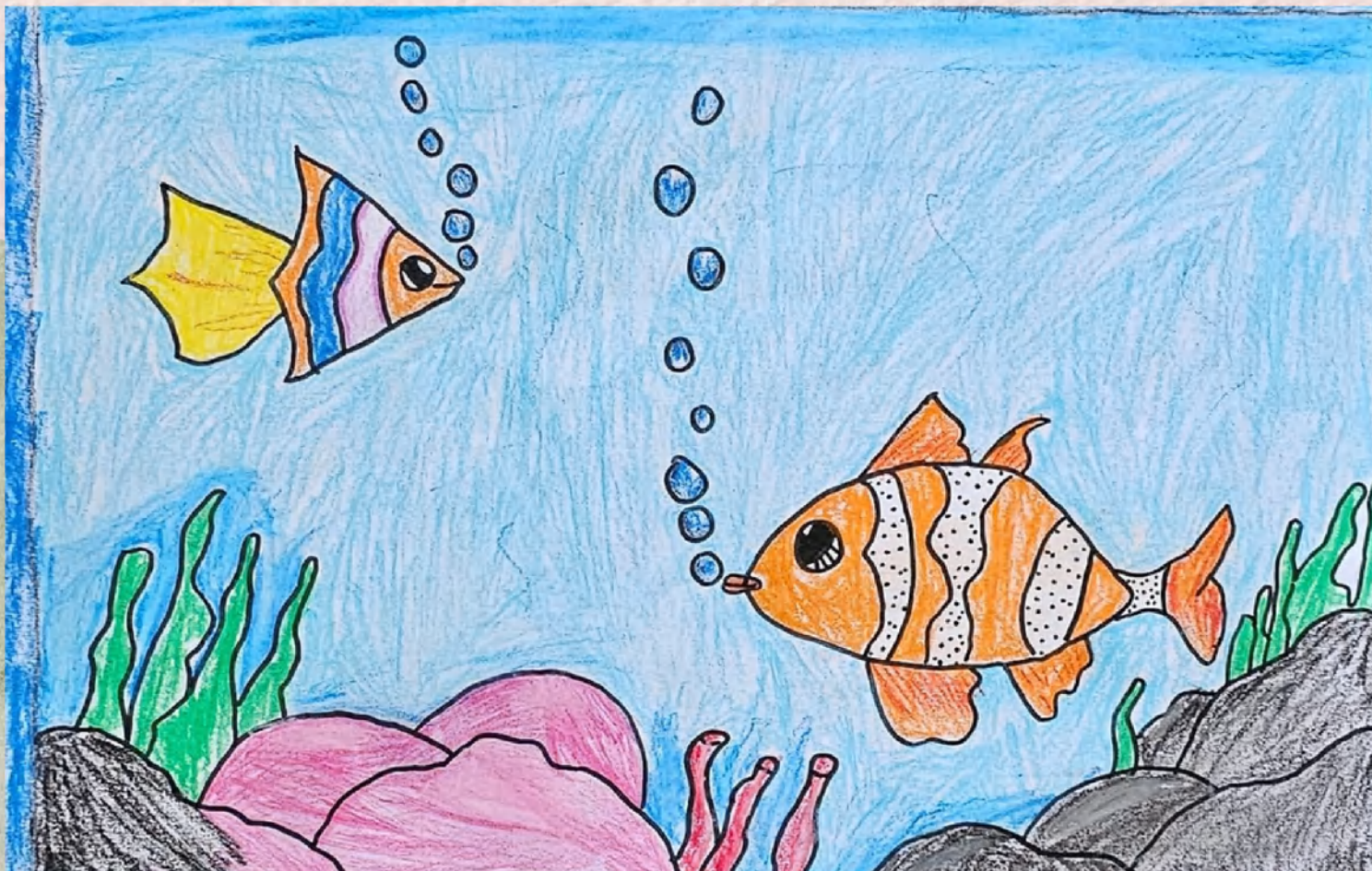
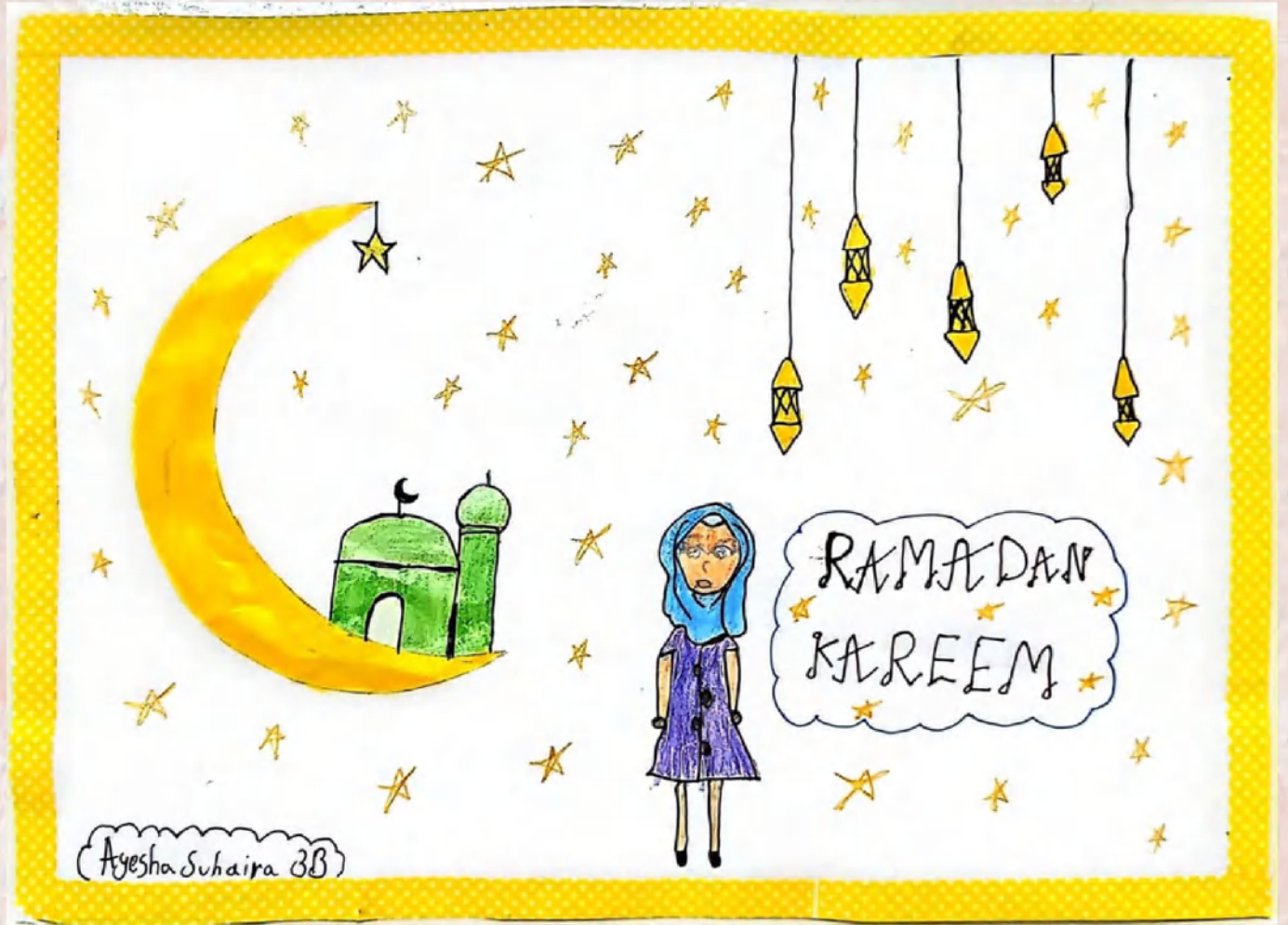

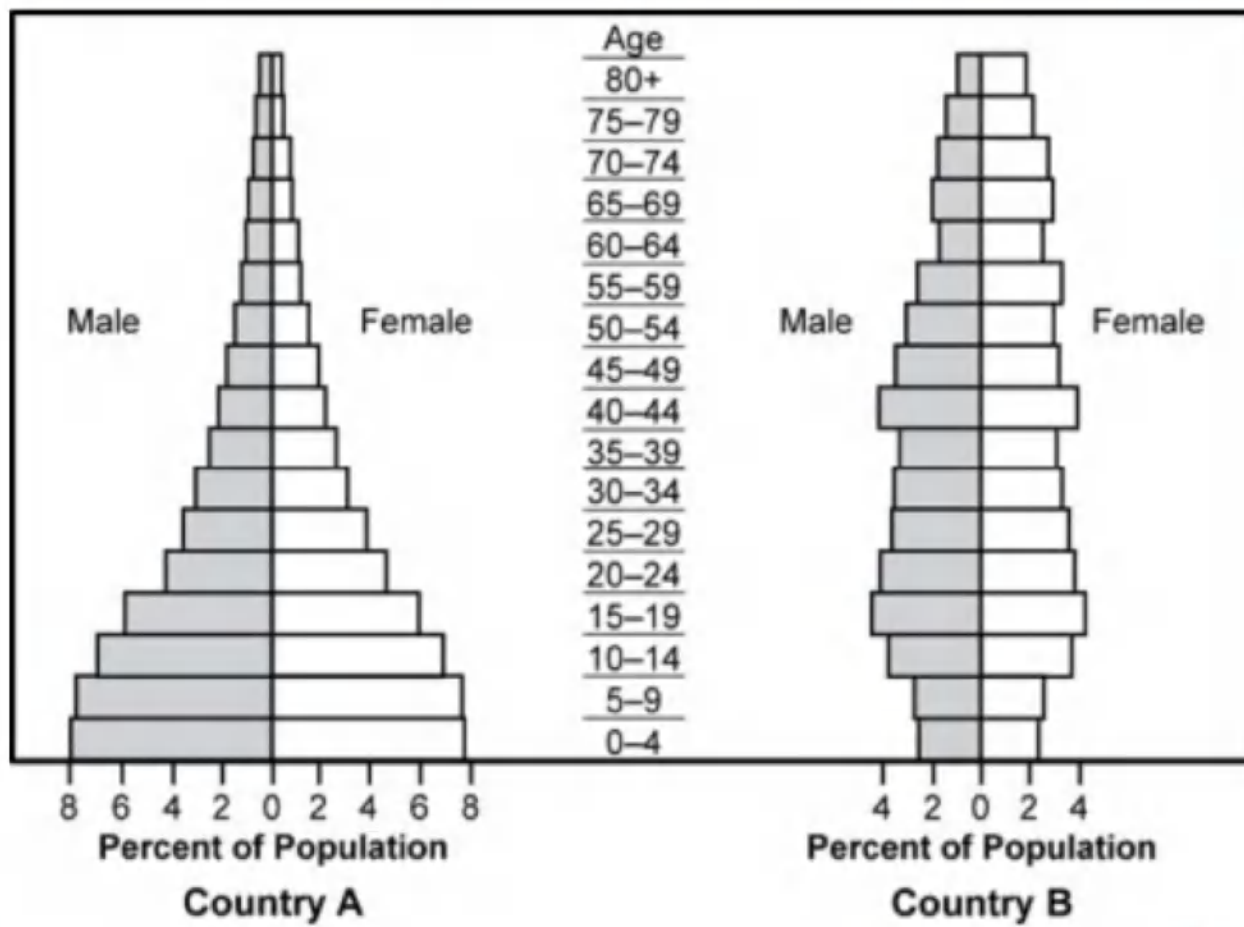
