

On 4 January, World Braille Day celebrates the importance of braille as a means of communication for people who are blind or visually impaired in realizing their human rights.


























Arabic Speakers- CBSE


Kite Festival








Annual Prize Day












































Verbal Bullying

The students of the junior school made various poster on verbal bullying and its effects.





































International Safer Internet day














International Thinking Day

Students of Our Own English High School Junior department actively participated and celebrated "World Thinking Day" on February 22nd, 2022.








































Emirati Children's Day

Importance of Inclusive Education By Ms. S Thulakshana

"If every child matters, every child has the right to a good start in life. If every child matters, every child has the right to be included. And that is so important for children with special needs." — Cherie Blair.

The key to inclusive education is when children are given the opportunity to learn together, they learn better. Inclusive education promotes teaching and learning among different and diverse students under one roof. Students from different races, religions, gender, and students with learning difficulties, gifted and talented are included in the inclusive education. Every child in their early years has the right to be supported by their parents and their community to grow and learn for positive development, and upon reaching school age, to go to school and to be included by teachers and peers alike. Inclusive education is including all the students in a school, classrooms, programs, and lessons where they can participate and learn together. Inclusive education values the unique contribution that every child brings to the classroom. In a genuine inclusive setting, every child feels safe and has a sense of belonging. A classroom with diverse students leads to better quality education for all children. This molds the students to respect individuality, differences and have an open mind to accept every individual who is unique. Inclusive education is important because it provides the context for a child's first relationship with the world outside their families, enabling the development of social and relationship interactions. Respect and understanding grow in students when it is planted in the initial stage of a child's life (Preschool), this could be achieved when students of different abilities and backgrounds are given the opportunity to play, socialize and learn together. When education is more inclusive, so are concepts of civic participation, employment, and community life. Separate or special education does not cater to students who need special attention, however inclusive education provides supportive, context-appropriate conditions for learning to demonstrate a better outcome.

Over the years, the importance of delivering inclusive education to all children has been highlighted across the world. This helps children to be part of their community, developing a sense of belonging and preparing them for life in the community as children and adults. It provides better opportunities for learning. Children with many abilities are most motivated when they learn in classes surrounded by other children. Successful inclusive education has the capacity to develop an individual's strengths and gifts. It gives the opportunity to the students to work on individual goals. Inclusive education also promotes parents' and local schools' involvement in education. It fosters a culture of respect and belonging. It provides an opportunity to learn about and accept individual differences and also promotes the development of friendships, relationships, and mutual respect among all students.

Good Schools not only include pupils but also classrooms. Inclusion can be applied in many ways school community and the link to the local community are the most obvious ones. Teachers play an important role in an inclusive setting. They have to be innovative in planning lessons for an inclusive setting. Finally, yet importantly, inclusion is one of the most important goals of the school to reach success.
