OVERVIEW: The young reader's award program by OUR OWN ENGLISH SCHOOL FUJAIRAH is the tribute to the great vision and wisdom of our beloved rulers. It is a reading motivation program to recognize outstanding reading skills for students of J1 to S5.

OBJECTIVES: The program has three main objectives: 1) to entice students to evince interest in contemporary literature for personal enjoyment, 2) to hone the literary skills, 3) to nurture lifelong readers who will continue to read for information needs and personal pleasure.

CRITERIA:

Gold standard - 30 books (Gold Star & certificate)

Silver standard - 20 books (Silver star & certificate)

Bronze standard - 10 books (Bronze star & certificate)

GUIDELINES:

- 1) Each student must read minimum of 10 books in a year (5 books of English and 5 books of Arabic are compulsory). Other than these, students can also read other language (Hindi, Malayalam) books of their choice.
- 2) Student should maintain a reading score card and book report which will be uploaded in the Library Team.
- 3) At the end of the Programme, students must submit to the class teacher, the reading score card, book reports and evidence to qualify in the reading award programme. The evidence can be of written, printed, video or PPT format.
- 4) Winners will receive certificate & star badge.
- 5) Last date to submit the reading score card, book reports and evidence for the reading Award will be January 31, 2023.
